PUBLIC HEARING: A Public Hearing will be conducted at this time to allow public input in accordance with Education Code Section 42127, subparagraphs (B) and (C) of paragraph (2) of subdivision (a), the governing board of a school district that proposes to adopt a budget, or revise a budget pursuant to subdivision (e), that includes a combined assigned and unassigned ending fund balance in excess of the minimum recommended reserve for economic uncertainties adopted by the state board, shall disclose during a public hearing a report of district reserves.

Mr. Geiger opened the Public Hearing at 7:59 p.m.

• Mrs. Beymer explained that this is a new requirement that was implemented last year. Districts are required to publicly disclose reserves in excess of the minimum requirement. The Governor implemented a cap on reserves for school districts. WUSD's reserve requirement is 3%. Even though the criteria has been met that would pull the trigger where we can have a reserve in excess of the minimum plus 2%, which would be 5% for WUSD, the District has to disclose why it has those excess reserves. Our total general fund budget is almost \$14 million, and we actually have \$975,000 over and above the minimum 3%. This amount of reserves would not even get us through two months of operating costs. Districts are not only to publicly disclose it, but it goes to the county office of education, so they can evaluate whether or not Districts have adequate reasons to have those reserves. Mrs. Beymer went over the report, and discussion ensued.
