The meeting was called to order by committee chair, Alex Parisio, at 5:32 pm. The minutes from the previous meeting were distributed and approved.

Mr. Crete asked if the WUSD board is considering adding an 8th grade ag program and shared what he believes the benefits of adding that program will be. It is not currently being considered, but the committee would like to revisit this topic at a later time.

We discussed advisory member terms. We appreciate everyone that is on the committee and want to make sure that no one feels like they are "stuck" on the committee. All members present stated that they would like to continue to serve on the committee, and Mr. Parisio is willing to continue servings as the chair.

An update of our current facilities and equipment projects were shared:

- Ag Truck was purchased and received in May and is being put to good use.
- The City and district cooperated on a project to change the grade of the entrance into the Ag yard area over the summer.
- Greenhouse The cooling pad cover is being completed by Trevor Geiger.
- The new C and C Plasma has been ordered and we are waiting to hear the delivery date.
- C and C laser engraver and a livestock trailer is on the list of items we would like to add to the department this year. Mr. Lindsey stated that when looking at engravers be sure to ask about the cost and frequency and software upgrades.
- The school barn facility is due for it's annual clean-up. This year that should include shoveling out the
 drain system, and knocking down all of the weeds. Maintenance has been putting out rodent bait
 regularly.

It is early in the year and we are unsure of the funding amount coming from CTEIG grant for the department this year. This money will be used to purchase equipment to continue improving what is available for student learning in the Agriculture area.

Advisors shared about the change in State FFA convention location to Anaheim and the concern about the increased cost of the conference to members. Mr .Fiack suggested contacting supporters and asking them to donate their airfare points to help cover transportation costs.

Mr. Massa shared that the Butte College Anniversary celebration will be held on Sept. 16th.

It was agreed that the next committee meeting will be scheduled for February as long as the program is not under an Advisory committee review for the Ag Incentive Grant.

Meeting was adjourned at 6:38pm
