• FPM Review was held January 13-16, 2020. Thank you to those staff members for providing supporting evidence and assistance in getting the review completed. We were monitored for Compensatory Education (Title I) and English Learners (Title III). Received one finding in the Compensatory Education area in regards to Title I allocation for Murdock Elementary. The Title I allocation in the 18/19 Consolidated Application (CARS) did not match the 18/19 School Plan budget report and the 18/19 expenditure reports. To fix the finding, we revised the 18/19 CARS for Title I school site allocation and

wrote a memo about how we will provide direct services to address the academic needs of our Title I students. The finding has been corrected.

Distributed and reviewed the 18/19 CAST (science) test results.
